Redecision Therapy, developed by Robert and Mary Goulding, combines Transactional Analysis with the techniques of Gestalt therapy to provide a powerful means of personal change. These workshops offer you an opportunity for intensive personal experience and 'hands-on' learning of the Redecision approach.

The workshop will include Redecision therapy sessions led by Mil Rosseau, teaching and discussion of Redecision theory and techniques, and small-group work where members of the group have the chance to practise Redecision therapy under Mil's supervision. This combination of personal work, practice and teaching is the format used by the Gouldings themselves in their famous 'marathon' workshops. It gives you an ideal opportunity to 'learn by doing'.

You will learn how to make contracts for Redecision work, how to make a treatment plan for Redecision, techniques of two-chair work and early-scene work, the Parent Interview, types of impasse and how to resolve them. Comprehensive handouts and reading guides will be provided.
